

## Finding a USB Serial Number in PALADIN

If you are submitting a demo request for CARBON, you will need to provide a USB serial number from a drive running the latest version of CARBON-PALADIN. Follow the instructions below to find your USB's serial number.

1. Boot to the latest version of CARBON-PALADIN. Follow the links below to get updated if you have not already:

2. Open the terminal and run the command **usb-devices | grep -B 5 usb-storage**. Find your USB in the list of hardware devices to acquire the serial number.
